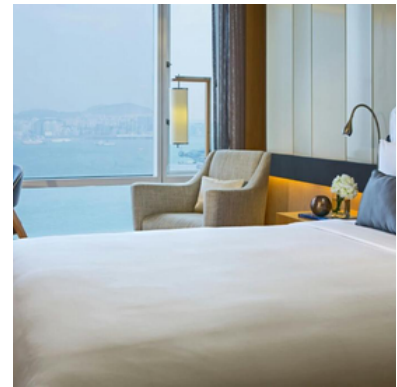
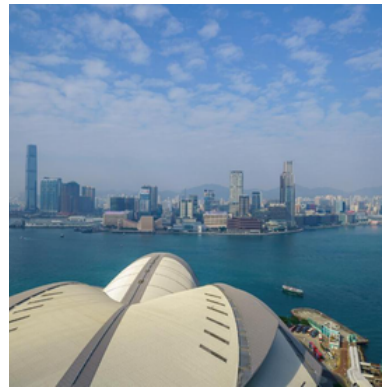

HOTEL OVERVIEW-RENAISSANCE HONG KONG HARBOUR VIEW HOTEL

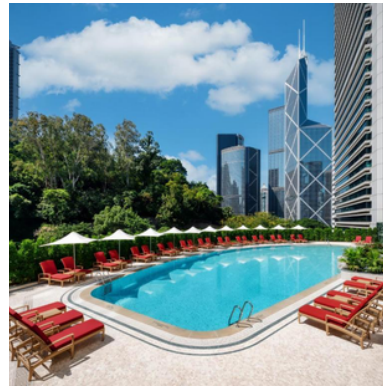

LANTAU ISLAND DAY TRIP

A Lantau Island day trip typically includes visits to the Ngong Ping Village, the Tian Tan Buddha (Big Buddha), Po Lin Monastery, and beautiful beaches. The journey often features a scenic cable car ride offering panoramic views and opportunities for sightseeing, cultural exploration, and relaxing walks through nature. It's a perfect blend of spirituality, nature, and culture in a single day.



HONG KONG STREET FOOD TOUR

A Hong Kong Street Food Tour offers a flavorful journey through the city's bustling markets and hidden gems, tasting iconic local dishes like dim sum, curry fish balls, egg tarts, pineapple buns, and stinky tofu. Guided by a local food expert, the tour combines savory and sweet bites with visits to vibrant neighborhoods such as Mong Kok, Sham Shui Po, and Central, revealing Hong Kong's rich culinary culture and history in a compact, tasty experience.



PEAK TRAM + OLD TOWN WALKING TOUR

A Peak Tram and Old Town Walking Tour in Hong Kong features a scenic ride to Victoria Peak, offering stunning city views, and a guided exploration of historic sites in the Central district, such as Hollywood Road, Man Mo Temple, and local markets. The tram, one of Asia's first cable railways, ascends nearly 400 meters, providing panoramic vistas. This compact tour combines scenic beauty with cultural heritage, ending at iconic landmarks and markets.

VICTORIA HARBOUR- NIGHT CRUISE

A Victoria Harbour night cruise in Hong Kong offers a relaxing boat ride with spectacular views of the illuminated city skyline and iconic landmarks. It often includes options to see the Symphony of Lights show, the world's largest light and sound spectacle, while enjoying unlimited drinks and snacks on board. Popular cruises include traditional junk boats like Aqua Luna, luxury yachts, and Star Ferry rides, making it a memorable way to experience Hong Kong's vibrant nightscape from the water.

HONG KONG DOLPHIN WATCHING

A Hong Kong Dolphin Watching Tour offers a half-day boat trip primarily around Lantau Island's waters, where visitors can observe the rare Indo-Pacific humpback pink dolphins in their natural habitat. The tour usually includes expert guides who provide insights into dolphin ecology and conservation efforts. Many tours combine dolphin watching with visits to Tai O Fishing Village and sometimes the Big Buddha, offering a blend of wildlife experience and cultural exploration. Sightings are frequent, with reputable operators reporting a 90%+ success rate, and eco-friendly practices are emphasized to minimize impact on the dolphins.

THE DRAGON'S BACK HIKING TOUR

The Dragon's Back hike in Hong Kong is a popular, scenic trail about 8-10 km long, offering stunning ridgeline views, lush forests, and a beachside finish at Big Wave Bay. It's a moderate, accessible walk suitable for most fitness levels, usually taking around 2-3 hours, with breathtaking panoramic vistas of Hong Kong's coastline and islands.

HONG KONG DISNEYLAND

Hong Kong Disneyland is a magical theme park featuring eight themed lands including Fantasyland, Tomorrowland, Adventureland, and Toy Story Land. Key attractions include Mystic Manor, Big Grizzly Mountain Runaway Mine Cars, the Iron Man Experience, and the newest addition, Frozen Ever After. The park offers a mix of thrilling rides, interactive shows, parades like the Friendtastic Parade, and opportunities to meet beloved Disney characters. It is a compact yet immersive Disney experience suitable for families and Disney fans, with many unique attractions exclusive to this park.
