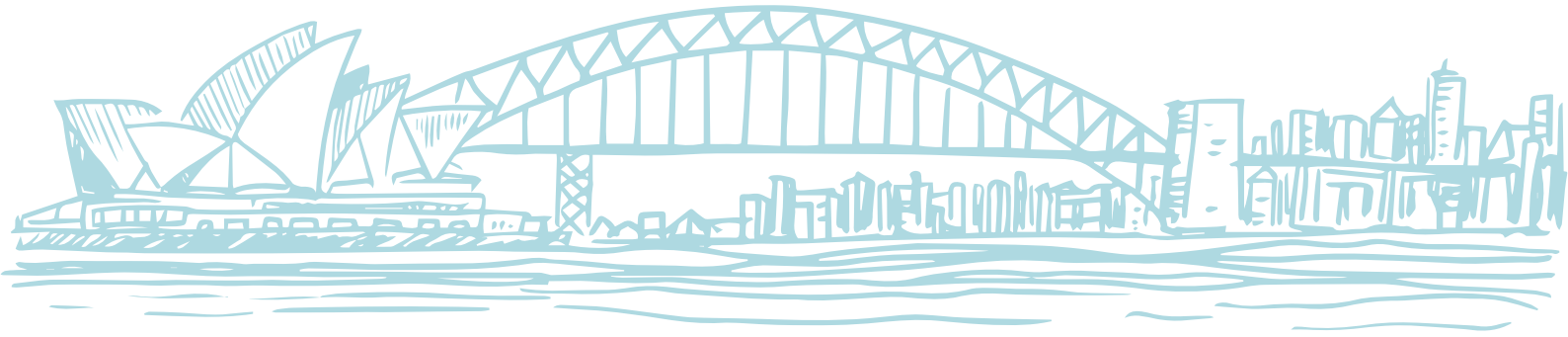

1. ESTER RESTAURANT AND BAR

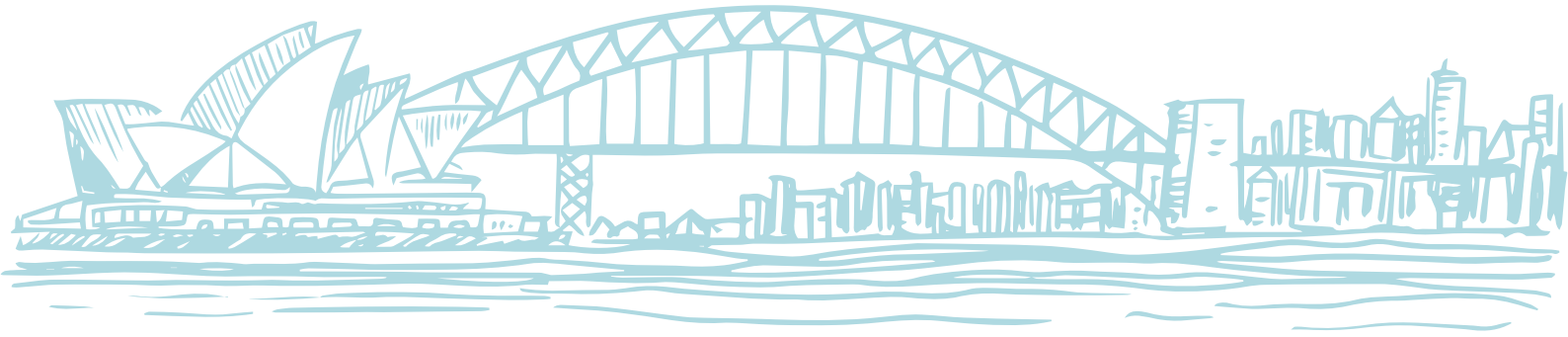

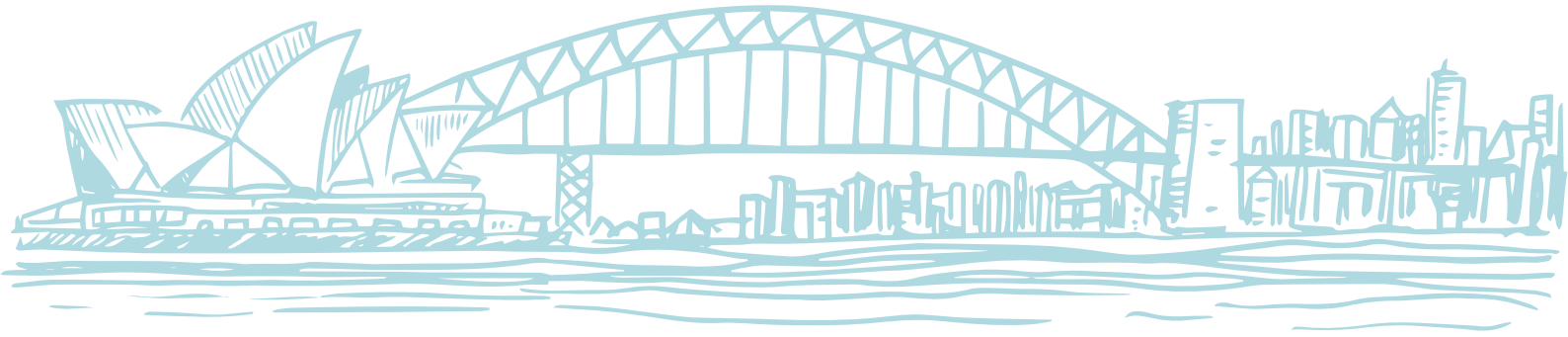

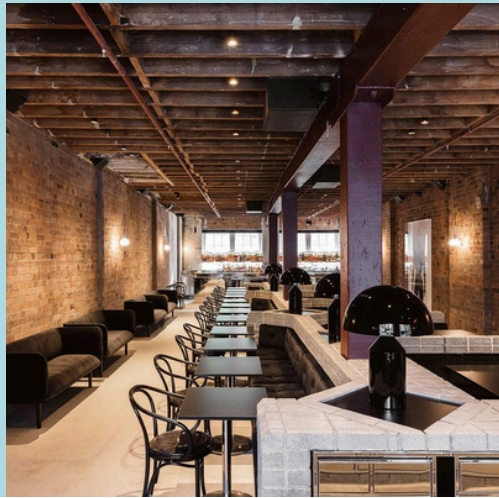
Don Pedros x Vue Bar (Bondi) transports that same fiesta energy to a beachside setting, making it a go-to for festive dining with a view.

SEAN'S BY SEAN MORAN

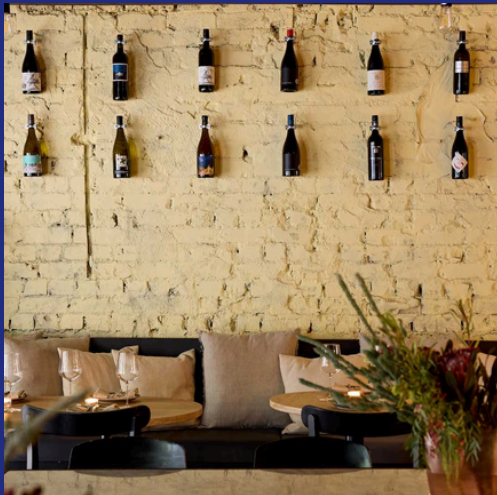

1. THE BAXTER INN (CBD, CLARENCE STREET)

2. CANTINA OK! (CBD, CLARENCE STREET)



Cantina OK!, a small bar in a laneway off Clarence Street in Sydney's CBD, is renowned for its intimate atmosphere and expertise in mezcal and tequila. With only 20 standing spots, it ranks among the World's 50 Best Bars, sourcing rare agave spirits from Mexico. The vibrant setting features colorful tiles and lively music, with bartenders offering insights into agave cocktails. Their hand-shaken margarita is a signature drink, making Cantina OK! a must-visit for cocktail lovers seeking an authentic taste of Mexico.
